Your Guide to Watering Wisely

Give your Tree a Good Watering As Soon as It's Planted!

Adjust for Conditions: Increase watering in hot, dry weather. Reduce during rainy periods. Adjust for specific tree needs and ensure good drainage.

Consistent Schedule:

First week: Every other day.

Next two months: Every 2-3 days.

After: Weekly or bi-weekly for a year to

establish roots.

Water Slowly: Use a soaker hose, drip irrigation, or TreeGator bag for slow, even water distribution deep into soil.

Mulching: Apply 2-3 inches of mulch, keeping it away from the trunkof the tree but covering the newly planted hole.
